Since the fall of 2018, Principal Curtis Long has been the principal at Scouters Mountain Elementary. With heavy hearts, we said good-bye to Principal Long at the end of the 2021-2022 school year, as he transitioned into the North Clackamas School District's (NCSD) Community Relations Director position.

With Principal Long's departure, we want to introduce you to our new Principal, Mike Potter! Mr. Potter has been working in the NCSD for his entire career. He started at North Oak Grove, now known as Oak Grove Elementary in Milwaukie. He taught Kindergarten, 4th, and 6th grade there. He then transitioned into an Assistant Principal position with Milwaukie/El Puente Elementary. After that, he became the principal of View Acres Elementary and most recently served as the principal for Sunnyside Elementary for the last five years.
